Maria Rosa wines originate from vines growing on loamy, calcareous soil. The particular micro-climate of the estate bequeaths wines rich in ripe tannins. Vine husbandry is rigorously sustainable, and yields are controlled to yield wines that are distinctly balanced and pleasant to drink.



SAROSA WINES

Sarosa is a range of 3 single variety red wines comprising of Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Sirakuzan. All the wines in this range are barrel aged for a minimum of 12 months in French oak. Each variety exhibits its particular characteristic fruitiness together with a subtle oak taste.



SPERANZA WINES

Speranza is a range of wines made from the same red grape variety, Sirakuzan. These wines show the different types of generic wines that can be made from the same variety of grape. They are all unique on the palate. They are fruity wines that compliment summer dishes.



SAROSA RESERVA

Sarosa Reserva is a range of red wines that have been aged in French oak barrels for not less than 24 months. They are robust wines with a good balance between ripe fruit flavours and oak nuances.
